Turas Learn: what is it and what does it offer you?

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What is Turas Learn?

- **Turas Learn** is one of the applications on the Turas Platform. Other applications include SOAR, Appraisal, Portfolio and People.
- Turas Learn is a learning management system which provides access to a variety of learning resources, courses and programmes for staff across health and social care.





Accessing Turas Learn

- Turas Learn is accessed using existing Turas usernames and passwords, no separate login is required.
- For example, SOAR is accessed using a Turas account. All Agenda for Change staff have a Turas account as they are required to use Turas Appraisal.
- There are lots of different learning sites within Turas Learn are set up with different access permissions e.g.
 - Some resources and programmes are locked down to specific groups
 - Some resources and programmes are open to all Turas Learn users
 - Some resources and programmes are open to the public (like a standard website)



Making learning resources available

- NHS Education for Scotland use Turas Learn to publish learning resources across a variety of topics and subject areas e.g. Pharmacy, Psychology, Leadership and Management, Digital Skills, etc
- Health Boards also use Turas Learn to make learning resources available for their own staff – e.g. NHS Fife providing learning modules for their staff only





Types of learning resources

- Variety of different types of learning resources are hosted on Turas Learn
 - eLearning modules interactive modules, with or without assessments completion recorded in Learning History
 - Learning Programmes structured programme of different learning resources/activities – completion recorded in Learning History
 - Facilitated courses attendance recorded in Learning History
 - Videos/animations engaging learning resources, not trackable
 - Word/PDF/Presentation documents variety of purposes, not trackable


